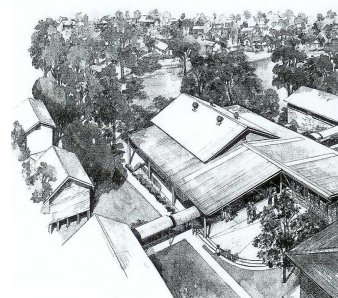

NAPLAN – LITERACY & NUMERACY 2010

This month the National Assessment Program-Literacy & Numeracy (NAPLAN) will be completed by students in years 3 & 5.

The results of the tests will provide important information about what the student can do and will be used to support teaching and learning programs. Parents will receive a report indicating their child's level of achievement. Each student's level of achievement will be reported against the national minimum standard.

The tests will be held on Tuesday 11 May (language & writing), Wednesday 12 May (reading) and Thursday 13 May (numeracy). Friday 14th May is a catch up day for the students who missed a test.

The tests will go ahead at Telarah Public School. Despite staff members being strongly opposed to the section of leave tables. At Telarah Public we

believe that league tables do not reflect the broad based and comprehensive range of learning that takes place in our schools through the many talents of our staff.

Staff members at Telarah Public School agreed to implement the NAPLAN tests so as to avoid other personnel who do not know our students' individual needs to administer the tests. We believe such action would have disadvantaged our students unfairly.

I will discuss NAPLAN further at the P & C meeting tomorrow morning.

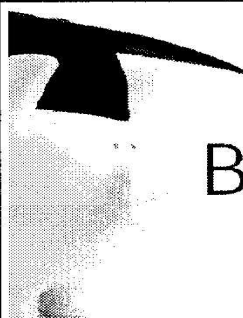
