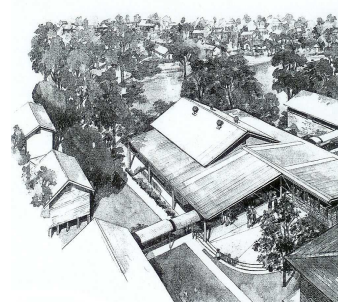

Resilience is the key to success and happiness. At Telarah Public School we teach resilience as part of the You Can Do It Program.

What can you do to promote resilience ? Here are a few suggestions:

- Finding something fun to do when to do going gets tough;
- Find some one to talk to when things are getting you down;
- Relax, take a breath;
- Don't think badly about yourself when you make a mistake;
- Be tolerant of others, accept that we all make mistakes sometimes;

- Don't blow things out of proportion, stay calm, take a deep breath and count to ten.

Try to figure out how to solve things when you have a problem.





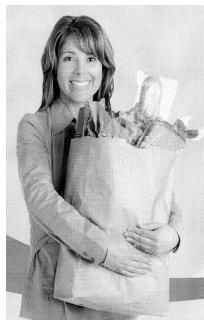
