

The Power of Speaking Positively

The most powerful way to change a child's behaviour is to reward and reinforce what we want to see, and ignore what we don't want to see.

In the classroom, this can be seen by teachers continually noticing students who do the right thing such as sitting quietly, getting on with their work or treating others with respect. Clear specific praise is the most powerful means of behaviour management.

In the whole school context, programs such as the WOW awards, Assembly Award Winners and student leadership opportunities reinforce the behaviours that we want to see at Telarah School.

In the playground, teachers notice students who play well, treat others with kindness and participate as a good sport.

In the home situation, continually speaking positively to your children about how they do the little things around the house, will make a huge difference to overall behaviour.

"I like the way you took your bowl up to the sink", or "I like the way you helped your brother", are comments which can have a huge impact on a child's ability to take responsibility for their actions.

We all want our children to be the very best they can be. Speaking positively is one way we can help them to achieve this.
