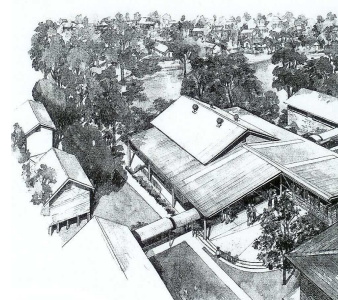

The new library and three classroom building is progressing nicely. They are currently working on the internal fit out with ground works being scheduled to begin soon.

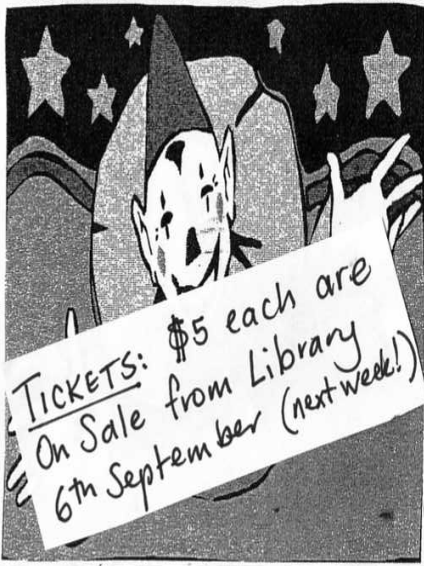
