Beach Excursion

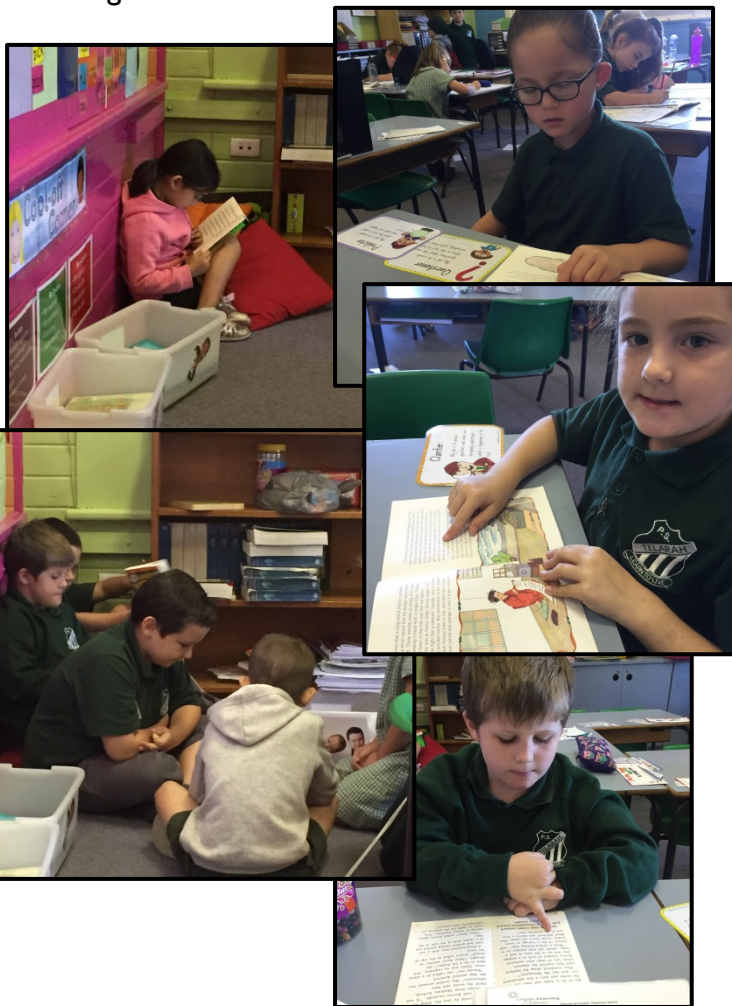

This is a process where students are each individually responsible for a reader role: Questioner, Clarifier, Predictor, Summariser and Leader. Students are involved in high level discussions and analysis of the text and are constructing learning independently. Even though we have only been learning and practicing Reciprocal Teaching for 4 weeks, the students are demonstrating enjoyment and willingness to apply their skills across the key learning areas.

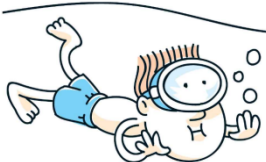

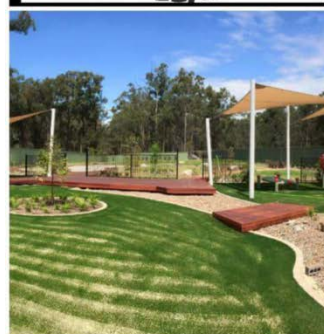
