Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability

Notification for Parents and Carers

All Government and non-Government schools across Australia are required to participate annually in the Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability (NCCD).

All Australian schools will collect data on their students who are receiving adjustments to meet additional learning and support needs in accordance with their obligations under the *Disability Discrimination Act 1992* and *Disability Standards for Education 2005*. This data will be provided to the Australian Government to assist in the development of a consistent, national picture of the education needs of students with disability.

The data provided to the Australian Government by the NSW Department of Education and Communities is provided in such a way that it cannot be used to identify any individual student or school.

Privacy Protection

The NSW Department of Education and Communities follows the requirements of the *Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act 1998* and the *Health Records and Information Privacy Act 2002*. Schools will collect, record, store and use data about individual students in line with these requirements. Data security and protection is a priority and students' personal details will be kept confidential.

Under Clause 52 of the Commonwealth *Australian Education Regulation 2013*, data collected by the NSW Department of Education and Communities for the NCCD must be provided to the Australian Government Department of Education and Training. This includes the number of students at each level of education, the number in each category of disability and the number at each level of adjustment. The information is provided to the Commonwealth as a series of number sets that cannot be used to identify any individual student or school.

The Australian Government Department of Education and Training follows the requirements of the Commonwealth *Privacy Act 1988* when handling any data provided by NSW Department of Education and Communities in connection with the national data collection. A privacy notice has been developed to by the Australian Government to provide students, parents and carers with important privacy information in relation to the data collection. Position:

KINDERGARTEN ENROLMENT 2017

We are now enrolling for the 2017 school year. Your child can start Kindergarten at the beginning of 2017 if they turn 5 on or before 31 July. By law, all children must be enrolled in school by their sixth birthday.

Each public school has a defined local enrolment area. This means your child is designated to a particular school based on the permanent residential address of the primary caregiver. Every public school reserves enough places within their school for students in their local enrolment area. Please see our school website for our zoning areas. Parents may however apply to enrol their child at a school outside their enrolment area. Non-local applications may be considered by the school's enrolment panel, according to the Department's policy and subject to selection criteria such as availability of appropriate staff and classroom accommodation. Contact the school for a non-local application form.

How to Enrol

Our school office has 2017 Kindergarten application packages available now. Parents and caregivers will need to collect an application package and complete the necessary forms and return all documentation to the school office so children can be included in our orientation programs.

Documentation required for enrolment:

- ☐ Completed 'Application to enrol in a NSW Government School' (available at the school office or website)
- ☐ Copy of your child's Birth Certificate or identity documents
- ☐ Proof of your child's address – originals of different documents such as your council rates notice or residential lease and electricity bill
- ☐ Immunisation history statement based on the Australian Childhood Immunisation Register (ACIR)
- ☐ Family Law or other relevant court orders (if applicable)
- ☐ Any health conditions requiring medication at school
