Our PBL this week is: Safe, Positive Learners in the Community. Over the holidays we ask students to be safe and have a great time, including doing some reading and physical activity every day!

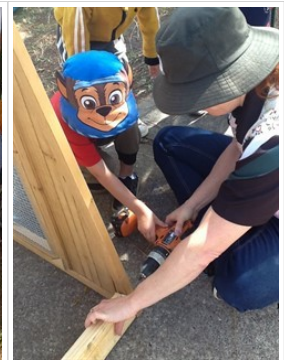
We hope everyone enjoys the holidays and comes back ready for a fantastic Term 4.
