Place your Canteen orders online with Flexischools

Our P&C has now introduced a new online ordering system for the **Canteen** (and Events & Fundraising in the future) called Flexischools. Many of you may be familiar with it as it is used at both Rutherford Public and Rutherford High. Getting online is easy and only takes a few minutes to register.

Flexischools makes it possible to:

- Order school lunches online at anytime
- Easily monitor special dietary requirements
- Select healthy choice options
- Pay for orders through Visa, Mastercard, Paypal or direct deposit

To set up your account follow the steps below:

REGISTER

- 1. Go to flexischools.com.au select the **REGISTER** button and enter your email address.
- 2. You will be sent a registration email with a link to the registration page.
- 3. Follow the instructions in the email to set up your account.
- 4. Once your account is set up, add your students and select their school and class.

ORDER

- 1. Go to flexischools.com.au and select the 'My Account' button and login.
- 2. To place an order, click on the 'Online Ordering' button for your student.
- 3. Select the items you wish to order.
- 4. Select your payment option and complete payment to place your order.

There is an online ordering fee of 29c per order and order cut-off time is 9am. If you have any issues setting up your account or ordering, please contact the FlexiSchools Customer Service Team on 1300 361 769, or you can contact them via their website.
